Parking Lot Rules

Absolutely no access to cars in the parking lot during morning break and tutorial – please plan accordingly. Violators will be assigned detention. This is a reminder that students must park in marked student stalls only and must have a valid parking permit posted on their vehicle. Any student parking on campus without a permit will be assigned a detention and will forfeit the ability to receive a permit at the start of the following semester. Students may not park on any curb unless given permission by the administration. Cars on the curb can be cited or towed.

Absence Protocol

Attention Northwood Families! Every absence from school must be cleared within THREE days of the absence. Absences must be cleared in one of the following ways:

1. Call (949) 936-7201 (NHS 24 Hour Attendance Line) each day your child is absent.
2. If a parent has not called, the student is expected to bring a written note from his/her parent/guardian to the Attendance Office upon returning to school. The note needs to include the following information:
 - a. Student's full name
 - b. Date of absence
 - c. Reason for absence
 - d. Full signature of parent/guardian with a daytime phone number

Skateboard Rules

Reminder: All skateboards must be properly stored in the locks by the bike racks or in a classroom. They may not be carried on campus and no longer be stored at the front desk of the administration building.
