- Want to learn how to produce several different styles of art from animation to realism to surrealism.

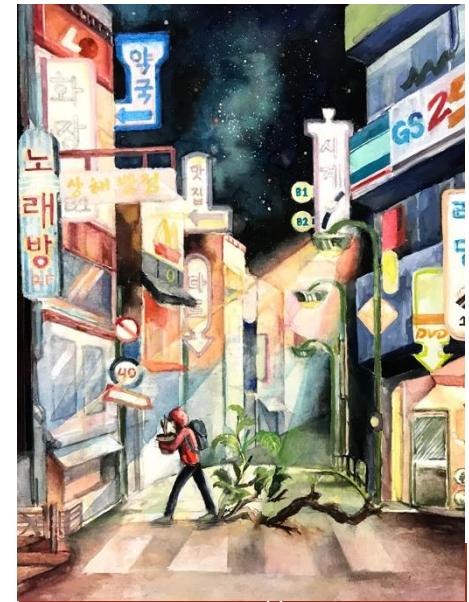
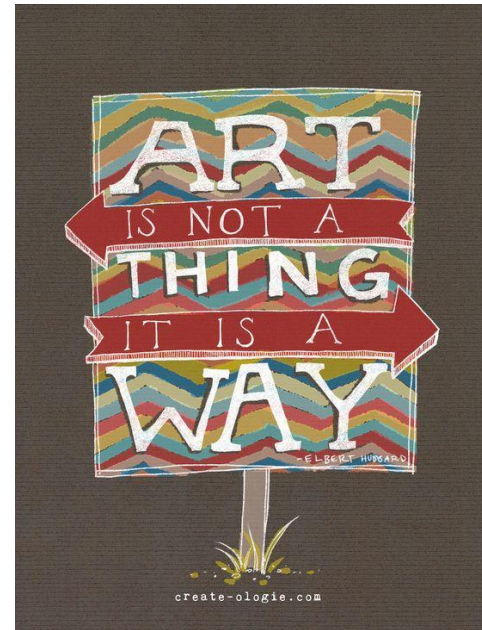
## Work We Do
