### NORTHWOOD HIGH SCHOOL STUDENT/PARENT PARKING AGREEMENT

Northwood staff is committed to the safety of our students and therefore, it is important that students with parking permits, and their parents, understand and agree to follow the parking expectations outlined below.

Students and parents, please review and initial next to each section. Your initials and signatures indicate that you understand and agree to each of the following expectations:

\_\_\_\_\_ Drivers must practice safe driving and abide by the laws at all times. This includes driving to and from school and in the parking lot. Reckless driving will result in immediate loss of the permit.

\_\_\_\_\_ The parking lot and vehicles are off limits during class time and passing periods. Students should not use their vehicles as lockers and will be able to access their vehicle before school, during breaks and during lunch only.

\_\_\_\_\_ Vehicles must be parked in designated areas (non-visitor/staff spaces) and have a valid permit at all times displayed in clear sight. Failure to display a valid permit will result in a violation.

\_\_\_\_\_ The PRIMARY vehicle is the vehicle that will PRIMARILY be driven to school by the student and will be issued the NHS parking permit. Any alternate vehicle driven to school should be listed on the application and registered with the Student Activities Center (SAC). If the vehicle is not listed on the permit, the student should email [MariyaBarin@iusd.org](mailto:MariyaBarin@iusd.org) **prior to the start** of the school day with vehicle information to avoid a parking violation.

\_\_\_\_\_ Students who are issued parking violations will incur the following consequences: Offense #1: warning; Offense #2: boot on car/two week probation; Offense #3: boot on car/\$50 fine/additional probation; Offense #4: vehicle towed at owner's expense/permit revoked

\_\_\_\_\_ Vehicles and contents in the Northwood High School parking lot are left at owner's risk. Prohibited items should not be stored in vehicles.

Parent/Guardian, please review the rules and regulations with your student. Your signatures below indicate that you have read and understand the parking expectations, and understand that parking permits are considered a privilege and can be revoked at any time for violations of the Timberwolf Code of Conduct (which includes attendance) and/or parking agreement. Incomplete applications cannot be accepted and can delay/prevent the issuing of a permit.
