Technical Theatre (Beginning & Advanced)

- Year-long courses (10 credits)
- A-G Eligible/CTE Pathway
- **Adv Teach:** prerequisite is Beginning Tech



- **Technical Theatre (Beginning):** Introduces students to the fundamentals of scenery, lighting, sound, props, costumes, and stage management.
- **Advanced Technical Theatre:** Design and build for Northwood productions, with opportunities to interview for leadership and crew roles.
- **What You Will Learn:** This pathway explores the total aesthetic effect of a production through hands-on training in design research, construction techniques, equipment maintenance, and the application of computer technology.

Why YOU Should Take

Technical Theatre

- Learn about live events and theater production
- Develop transferable skills that are relevant to various careers including architecture, construction, management, computer programming, animation, special effects, and engineering.
- Apply math, art, geometry, physics, history, electronics, and language skills while at the same time learning to use power tools, paints, materials, audio-video, lighting, and computers



Drama (Creative, & Advanced)

- Year-long courses (10 credits)
- A-G Eligible
- **Int Drama:** prerequisite is Creative
- **Adv Drama:** prerequisite is Intermediate



Creative Drama: No experience necessary! Explore performance through improvisation, pantomime, and theatre games to build foundational stage skills.

Intermediate Drama: This level encourages innovation through scripted drama, film projects, and a deeper focus on characterization and voice.

Advanced Drama: This intensive course is intended for motivated students to immerse themselves in theatre history, playwrighting, directing, and the technical rigors of preparing a full production.

What You Will Learn: Students develop a diverse professional toolkit including public speaking, creative problem solving, empathy, and advanced memory skills that are applicable both on stage and in daily life.
