To receive a permit for the first day of school, seniors should submit completed applications by **August 14th**

GENERAL INFORMATION



Parking permits will be available to all seniors who:

- have a current license and registration
- attended a Smart Start Presentation
- qualify based on attendance and Code of Conduct records*

A school permit is required to park on campus starting on the first day of school!

CLASS OF 2026 - JUNIORS

A limited number of permits are available for eligible* students and granted through a lottery. Junior applications are different and more information will be posted on the website. Apply by August 14th to be eligible for a permit for the first day of school.

*Eligibility is based on attendance and Code of Conduct records for the previous semester as well as Smart Start attendance. Students with multiple prior violations will be given an initial probationary period upon their completion of the application.



Important Information for Parents & Students Smart Start Presentation Required for Parking Permit

Smart Start is a safe driving presentation provided by the Irvine Police Department in collaboration with IUSD to ensure the safety of our students beginning their driving careers. **Each of our high schools will require SMART START attendance and participation for students interested in obtaining a school parking permit.** For this reason, IUSD administration and the Irvine Police Department have identified various dates, times, and locations for the presentation and welcome students from IUSD high schools to attend any session.

Students (grades 9-12) may participate in the presentation before or after receiving their driver's license and need a school parking permit. Student attendance for the entirety of the presentation is required to gain a parking permit and is sufficient for the remainder of the student's high school career. Of course, students interested in brushing up on their driving skills are encouraged to attend more than once during their high school experience. We also encourage and welcome parents to accompany their child to the presentation as the content is relevant for all drivers.

Presentations will begin promptly at the identified time, and students must be present for the full presentation to be eligible for the parking permit. Thank you for your cooperation! We're hopeful that our collaboration with the Irvine Police Department will impact the safety of our students and other citizens both on and off IUSD campuses.
