### 1-Semester Completer Course

#### Prerequisites for CIE 2

To enroll in this course, students must have completed Careers in Education 1, and earn a recommendation to move on to the completer course.



### Is it different than C.I.E. 1?

Yes! This second course will build on the concepts learned in C.I.E. 1, but will focus on observing teachers and working with students. Each week will be spent planning for & participating in work with teachers and students.



### When can I take this course?

You can take this course in back-to-back semesters OR non-sequentially. Once you've taken & passed Careers in Education 1, you can take this completer course in a future semester.



### College Articulation

We're working with local Community Colleges & Universities to allow you to earn credit toward some college programs when you complete this pathway!



### Course Outcomes

- Collaborate with mentor educators to facilitate learning for other students.
- Practice essential educational skills including communication, planning, instruction and assessment.
- Build learning environments and experiences to meet the needs of specific groups of students.
