(open to ALL students)

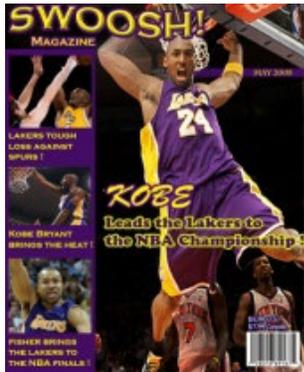
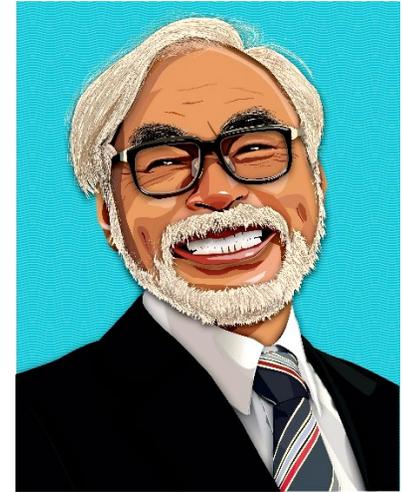
Intro to Computer Graphic Design is a beginning course that explores how to utilize artistic elements and principles of design in computer graphic software and media. The class is designed to allow students the opportunity to learn various graphic and desktop publishing software programs such as Photoshop, InDesign and Illustrator. This course is a great course for any student and will help students be able to understand layout and composition that benefits them in all of their other subjects. **(1 year course)**

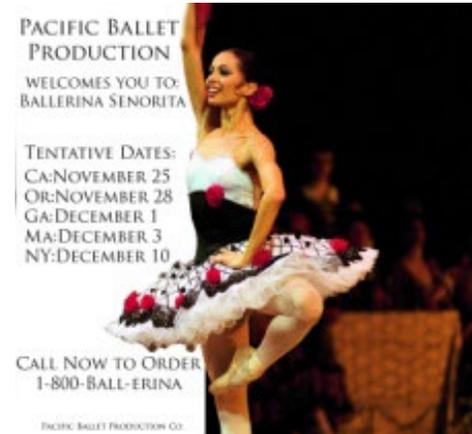

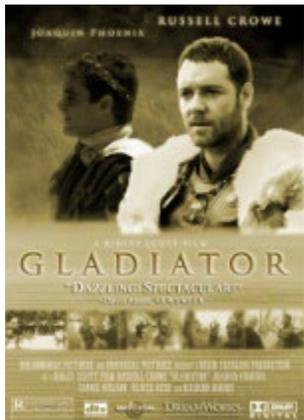
- Create movie posters
