Student E-Vehicle Registration Form

NHS students will be able to park and lock their registered e-bike, e-scooter and/or e-skateboard in one of the approved bike rack areas. E-vehicles parked without a registration sticker or in an unauthorized location on campus will be issued the following:

1st offense: Warning
2nd offense: Detention

3rd offense: Bike locked by school & two detentions
4th offense: Suspension of registration sticker

Students who meet the following requirements will be eligible for a registration sticker:

- Attendance at an e-Vehicle Safety Presentation prior to issuance of a registration sticker.
- Students must qualify based upon their attendance and Code of Conduct record during the previous semester. For example, in order to remain eligible for a permit for the Fall Semester, a student must have no more than **ten points** due to tardies/uncleared period absences and no Code of Conduct violations during the previous semester.

NOTE: Three tardies equal one point and one uncleared period absence equals two points.

E-Bike Operation Expectations:

- Students will walk their e-bike, e-scooter, or e-skateboard, respectfully and safely at all times on campus
- Students will wear appropriate protective gear when riding, including helmet.
- Students will park and lock their e-bike, e-scooter, or e-skateboard in an authorized bike rack location ONLY.
- Registration stickers must be visibly displayed on the frame of the e-bike, e-scooter, or e-skateboard.
(Registration stickers are non transferable from person to person)

Consequences for not meeting expectations:

- Students not meeting expectations may receive detention.
- Students who accumulate 10 points (see above) in the current semester may lose their parking privilege.
- Excessive violations may result in suspension of registration sticker.
- NHS Administration reserves the right to revoke any permit if any of the above expectations or other expectations in the Timberwolf Code of Conduct are not met.

To qualify for a registration sticker, you will need to do the following:

- Attend e-Vehicle Safety Presentation (indicate date on application).
- Complete online application
- Upload this document (signed) to the online application form.
