Course Description

This course series begins with Korean 1, an introduction to the Korean alphabet system, language, and culture. Students will acquire a basic understanding, along with essential skills to communicate at a basic level.

Korean 2 and Korean 3 build upon the basic knowledge students gained in Korean 1. These courses require students to use prior knowledge, and also introduce students to new vocabulary, structures, and expressions. Students expand their vocabulary range to include more sophisticated language expressions, and engage with various forms of authentic texts (dramas, shows, music).
