
SCHOOL PROFILE

Northwood High School

Northwood High School (NHS) is one of five comprehensive high schools in Irvine, CA. Located in the uppermiddle class suburban neighborhood of Northwood, NHS is a WASC accredited, California Distinguished School and US Department of Education Blue Ribbon School. NHS currently serves approximately 2,200 students in grades 9 through 12. NHS addresses a range of student needs and abilities with a student-centered focus. While our profile touts the skills and abilities of



our university-bound students, we take great pride in our entire community of NHS learners whose talents, though varied, are limitless. Due to COVID-19, students were given the option to attend Irvine Virtual Academy (IVA) for 100% online instruction. Seniors who chose to attend IVA this school year will still be receiving their high school diploma from Northwood High School. The Class of 2021 consists of 516 students – 439 NHS students and 77 IVA students.

SCHEDULING

NHS operates on an alternating block schedule where courses meet for 90 minutes every other day. Semester classes are 18 weeks and yearlong classes are 36 weeks. Students are limited to 6 classes per semester with the exception of those students participating in Performing Arts, Athletics, Leadership, MUN, Newspaper, Speech and Debate, or Yearbook.

CORE CURRICULUM

Students in grades 9 and 10 are expected to complete our core curriculum:

Grade 9 - Humanities: World Literature and World History, Mathematics, Integrated Science 1, two semesters of physical education, and an elective of their choice.

Grade 10 - Humanities: US Literature and US History, Mathematics, Integrated Science 2, and an elective of their choice.

FORENSICS CORE

The Forensics Core is a distinct, yearlong crosscurricular honors program that sets out to investigate criminal behavior through scientific, psychological, and philosophical lenses. This inquiry-based program consists of three courses: Forensic Science, Forensic Psychology, and Critical Theory and Literature and immerses students in a transdisciplinary experience devoted to developing a wellrounded understanding of human behavior.

INTEGRATED CURRICULUM

NHS offers a challenging, comprehensive high school program highlighting an innovative science and mathematics curriculum. Students who choose to complete Integrated Science 1. 2. 3* will have met all the Next Generation Science Standards (biology, physics, chemistry, earth and space). The completion of Math 3 is equivalent to Algebra 2 and the completion of Math 4 is equivalent to Pre-Calculus. *not required

RANKING

The Irvine Unified School District prohibits the numerical ranking of students. NHS will provide percentile range rankings when requested by universities and scholarship organizations. Highest GPA: Class of 2019 – 4.56

GRADING SCALE

Students are awarded 5 credits for a passing

NHS offers a rich array of Honors courses in the 9th and 10th grades leading to weighted Honors and Advanced Placement opportunities primarily in grades 11 and 12. Teacher recommendations are required for Honors and AP course placement.

CONCURRENT ENROLLMENT


NHS is centrally located between UC Irvine and multiple community colleges. Some students augment their course loads with transferable college level courses. We believe that concurrent college course work expands and enriches a college-bound student's opportunity to explore areas of personal interest. In addition, under an agreement with Chapman University students can complete Math 110 (Single Variable Calculus I) and Math 111 (Single Variable Calculus II) on the NHS campus while earning units at Chapman University. As with any concurrent coursework, students are advised to list courses on their application and forward an official college transcript. These courses will not be posted on the final NHS transcript.

GRADUATION DATA

69.6% of our 2020 graduates chose to attend a four-year university, while 30.4% elected to attend community colleges or technical schools.

The Class of 2020 had a 99.2% graduation rate with 487 students meeting graduation requirements.
