Advanced Film/Broadcast News (NTV)

This class is the capstone of all of the production classes. Students will function in a true production environment as they are involved in in the production of the school's weekly news show. Students organize, produce, and create segments for broadcast. Film production is another facet of this class, as students will create their own short films for student film competitions and local distribution. Lastly, students create "video yearbook" chapters that cover the groups and events that take place at NHS.

Prerequisite: Teacher Recommendation, production reel, interview.

This course prepares students to enter the video production industry with an emphasis in pre-production and post-production techniques. Students will learn about the development of the film and television industry and study the techniques used by filmmakers and broadcasters. Training includes production planning, and advanced editing, and camera operation techniques. The Adobe Suite of editing products will be used.
