Many of you have seen Superintendent Walker's email indicating that as of this afternoon **all IUSD schools will now be closed up until Monday, April 6.** We are postponing or canceling ALL non-school day activities and special events. This includes parent meetings, field trips, athletics competitions and practices, and club meetings.

On Monday and Tuesday of next week, all staff will be trained on Emergency Distance Learning (EDL) with the intention of going live on Wednesday so that student learning can continue while they are at home. The goal is to have EDL active through Friday, March 27. Starting March 30, all students and staff will be on the scheduled Spring Break. Regular in-person instruction will resume Monday, April 6. **Please watch for future emails providing more details.**
