

SPANISH 1

Course Description:

- Spanish 1 introduces students to the four basic language skills: listening comprehension, reading comprehension, speaking, and writing, within a cultural context.
- Students ...
 - ... are introduced to the language system and communicate in the interpretive, interpersonal, and presentational modes of communication through listening, speaking, and writing.
 - ... practice learning Spanish basics with topics that include greetings, the alphabet, numbers, personality + physical characteristics, foods, school, calendars, free time activities, family, etc.
 - ... watch videos or listen to audios in Spanish and then describe or show evidence of comprehension.
 - ... communicate around topics related to their own life as well as topics related to Spanish-speaking cultures.
